## Annual Book Gift Tree


NOV 1-DEC 7



### The Creative Studio

Book some time in our media lab to get your family photos in shape this holiday season. **Digitize old prints**—you can scan hundreds in minutes—as well as **VHS tapes** or even **film strips**, enhance them using iPhoto or Photo-shop, and make a **slideshow** for viewing over the holidays. Bring some of those old holiday music **LPs** in and load them onto your mp3 player. You can even **bring in a guitar or play on our keyboard** to record your own Christmas mix using GarageBand. The possibilities are endless in the Creative Studio—make an appointment today!

Take our **GoPro camera** with! This head-mounted device is extremely popular with fans of extreme sports. Record a fast-paced ski or snowboard video or wait for warm weather and strap it to a bike or skateboard.

### Big Projects Beware!

Come prepared to save your project to an external device—our computers wipe clean when they restart (for security reasons). We recommend patrons bring a USB drive—some projects even require it—but a blank CD will do in a pinch. We also have a few **500GB hard drives** available to check out and take home if you're working with something especially large. Email only goes so far!


