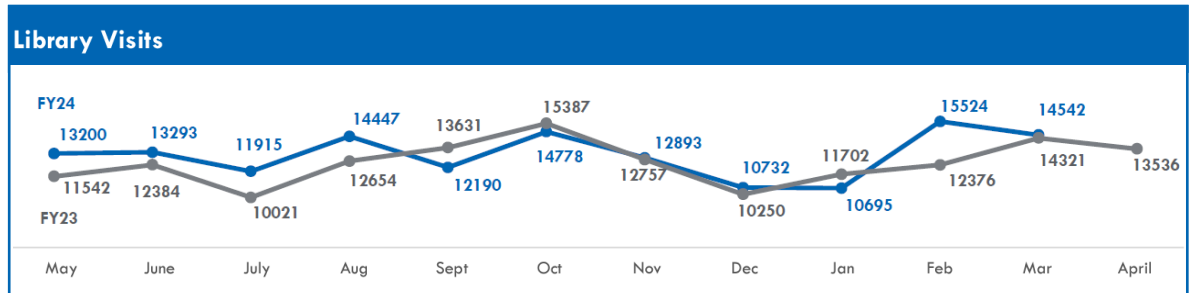

SHARING OUR STORY | BY THE NUMBERS

As part of our Strategic Plan, one of our priorities is to share our story. To see how well we're doing and how we're helping our community, we collect and study data and numbers that show our impact.

We update a monthly report of these statistics at addisonlibrary.org/Sharing-Our-Impact.

Let's take a closer look at one of the charts from that report:



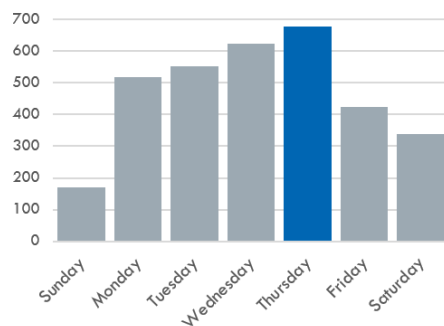
What is it?

The chart above shows how many total people visited the library each month, which is collected using a door counter at the library entrance. The blue line above shows visitors this fiscal year, and the gray line shows last fiscal year in comparison. **In February 2024, over 15,500 people visited the library!**

What do we learn from these numbers?

It's important for us to analyze our door count numbers to understand staffing needs, trends in library use, program and circulation patterns, and how our patrons are using the library. Here's what we've learned:

On average, Thursdays are our busiest day of the week!



We're open 68 hours per week. On Thursdays, we average 56 patrons coming through our doors each hour!



We've had over 1 million library visitors in the past 6 years!
